

Members, Applicants Sought for Stationary Engineer Positions in Pacific Northwest

M.E.B.A.'s new contract with Commercial Transcontinental Services (CTS) will put members to work in shoreside positions as soon as early March. CTS is now accepting resumes for members to serve as temporary facilities engineers in the Seattle, Portland and Spokane areas.

Jobs will range from 1–90 days in duration, and generally run from 8-5 each day. This is covered employment for medical, training and pension purposes.

M.E.B.A.'s Executive V.P. Adam Vokac is the point of contact and is accepting resumes. This deal was crafted some months back but the company needed to complete preparations to accommodate this new arrangement.

We are now ready to go to the next phase and interested members and applicants in the Pacific Northwest are encouraged to submit a current resume along with copies of their USCG officer's license and current M.E.B.A. drug test to Adam at avokac@mebaunion.org.

If this arrangement proves successful, there could be additional opportunities in other West Coast locations including Oakland and Los Angeles.
